Background of the Trip

Last March 18-19, 2023 at N Hotel, Kauswagan of Cagayan de Oro City conducted a 2-day Training of Trainers on Child Protection, Mental Health and Psychosocial Support Services and Psychological First Aid Training. SaferKidsPH project which is "Enhancing Child Protection System to Keep Filipino Children Safe Online Program". In which Phil. Island Kids Int'l. Foundation Inc. (PIKIFI), is the local project implementor.
